

## ABOUT ESSENTIAL ELEMENTS “MY EE LIBRARY”

First of all, a reminder that both the older and newest versions of Essential Elements have the same contents and exercises. The difference is in how you access play-along and other features. The older versions came with a CD or DVD/CD ROM which are still worthwhile. However, for the newest version, all tools and features are accessible online or you can order the CD Rom for free if you prefer.

Either way, anyone can use the tools available online at **Hal Leonard’s Essential Elements My Library**. Included are play-along tracks for all the exercises #1-187, the start-up video, additional music and a listening library all for your specific instrument.

Go to [myEElibrary](#). If you have the newer title, **Essential Elements for Band**, there is a student code on the title page of the book to enter in the student activation code box. If you have the older version, **Essential Elements 2000**, click where it says “My Book Doesn’t Have a Code.” On the next page that opens you will enter the 10 or 13 digit ISBN from the book you do have and you will be able to access all the features listed above. The ISBN code also gets you to the correct instrument.

*Practicing with recordings should help the student HEAR if they are playing the notes correctly.*
